Mower County COVID-19 Relief Fund Small Business Grant

Small Business Grant Guidelines and Application

The Mower County Board of Commissioners has allocated \$1 million to support small businesses with financial hardship as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Mower County COVID-19 Relief Fund (MCCRF) will provide one-time grants up to \$10,000 to eligible applicants to assist with payroll, rent, mortgage payments, utility bills, and other operational expenses that occurred between March 1, 2020 and June 30, 2020. The MCCRF will be jointly administered by Mower County and the Development Corporation of Austin (DCA).

Eligibility

Businesses must meet all of the following criteria:

- Businesses or animal agriculture operations with a physical establishment in Mower County, including locally-owned franchises, home-based businesses and mobile businesses.
- The owner must be a permanent resident of Mower County or one of the counties immediately adjacent to Mower County.
- Businesses must have no more than 50 full-time equivalent employees. Employees for this grant program may be either W-2 employees or independent contractors.
- Businesses must have been operating before March \$2019.
- Businesses must be in good standing with the Minnesota Secretary of State and Minnesota Department of Revenue as of March 1,2020.
- Businesses must demonstrate financial hardship due to COVID-19 between March 1, 2020 and June 30, 2020.
- Businesses who received federal funds in the Payment Protection Plan (PPP) and Emergency Incident Deferment Loan (EIDL) are eligible, but Mower County CRF dollars must be used to cover different expenses over and above what was covered by PPP and EIDL.

Certain businesses are ineligible, including:

- Corporate chains, multi-state chains.
- Businesses that primarily derive income from gambling.
- Businesses that derive any income from adult entertainment.
- Businesses that primarily sell pawned merchandise, guns, tobacco or vaping products.
- Businesses that derive income from passive investments; business-to-business transactions; real estate transactions; property rentals or property management; billboards; or lobbying.
- Businesses who received the Minnesota Small Business Relief Grants approved by the Minnesota State Legislature and signed by Governor Tim Walz on June 16, 2020.
- Lending institutions, law firms, utility companies, residential rental properties, production agriculture, insurance agencies, financial advisors.

Application Process and Timeline

Applications accepted August 10 through August 31. The MCCRF Grant application must be

completed in its entirety by the applicant and submitted by 4:30 pm, August 31, 2020. If assistance is needed in processing the application, call 507-433-9495. A pdf version of the application will be made available upon request.

If applications from eligible businesses exceeds the funds available, grant recipients will be ranked by need until funds are exhausted. Priority of awards will be determined by the impact of Governor Walz COVID-19 Executive Orders limiting businesses operations and by percentage of loss between March 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020 as compared to the same period on 2019. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
